## The District

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The Ohio Hi-Point Career Center develops our most valuable resource--people--by providing quality career-technical and academic education programs.

Our High School and Satellite Divisions serve juniors and seniors from 14 school districts and offer more than 30 career training programs, while our Adult and Continuing Education Division provides a resource for adult learners to refresh or renew their skills and create a career or college pathway.

Since our school district first opened its doors in Bellefontaine in 1974, Ohio Hi-Point Career Center has grown and expanded to meet the growing needs of our five county, 14 partner school district service area.

Each year we service over 1,500 high school students on our Bellefontaine Campus and at our various satellite locations, as well as meeting the needs of over 3,000 adult learners from Auglaize, Champaign, Hardin, Logan and Union Counties and beyond.

Many of our high school and adult education programs offer articulation agreements, which allow for students to earn college credit in our programs and transfer those credits to a 2-or-4 year college or university.

## The Community

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The school campus is located one mile east of State Route 33, within the city limits of Bellefontaine. The District has easy accessibility to Columbus, Dayton, and Springfield, and to smaller cities like Marysville, Urbana, Kenton, Lima, Sidney, Wapakoneta, and Piqua.
